| | Important Information Regarding Nominations |

| 1 | The <i>Minimum Training Standard (MTS)</i> : Garda vetting, Induction, TUSLA, CFR and Manual Handling is an essential course requirement for ALL courses in the Civil Defence College. |
| 2 | The College Programme schedule is what we have committed to deliver; there may be additional courses added during the year. |
| 3 | A volunteer is expected to recertify before the current certification expires. Due to the pandemic, PHECC are currently allowing a 3-month extension to the recertification period. However, it is important to note; that when a certificate expires, the volunteer <i>cannot practice</i> until the recertification course and assessment has been successfully completed. |
| 4 | Civil Defence College will not contact any Instructor to inform them of their current status. It is the Instructors responsibility to meet the criteria and through their CDO be nominated to attend for recertification. When VEMS is introduced; Volunteer Instructors will get reminders of certification expiry dates. |
| 5 | We are asking you to take time to consider who you need to nominate for instructor courses and that they meet the Minimum Training Standard. |
| 6 | When submitting nominations for the PHECC Responder Instructor Courses (CFR, CFRA, FAR & EFR), please ensure there are sufficient students requiring training to allow each student meet the PHECC assessment criteria, The PHECC Education & Training Standard requires Responder Instructor students to be involved in three courses (assist on one, be supervised on one and finally be monitored). All three stages must be completed as part of the PHECC assessment standard in order for instructor status to be awarded. We require this process to be completed within a 3-month period following course completion. |
| 7 | We will be requesting the assistance of PHECC Tutors and Facilitators in respect of PHECC Courses and Assessment. We will hold a workshop in the coming weeks for this group. |
| 8 | Where you are considering nominating more than one volunteer for the same course please put them in order of preference. A waiting list, where appropriate, will be drawn up for each course. |
| 9 | Please update the Volunteer Records to reflect where Volunteer Instructors may no longer be available to instruct, as when a course is oversubscribed, we will use current active Instructor numbers as part of the selection process. Please notify College also as the specific faculty lists will need to be amended. |
| 10 | Please note; 100% attendance is required for training programmes. |
| 11 | Nomination Forms must be submitted to nominations@defence.ie as soon as possible, and no later than 4 weeks before the start date of a course. Please Note: the exception is some of the earlier courses on the programme are for people already identified – the relevant CDOs will be contacted directly |
